

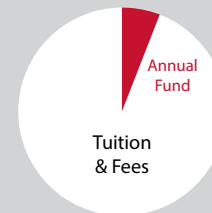


# North Cross School

## HONORING LEADERSHIP DONORS TO THE ANNUAL FUND

The Head of School's Society is North Cross School's recognition society honoring our most generous donors to the Annual Fund. Leadership gifts account for nearly 80% of the resources raised through the Annual Fund. Because leadership donors provide an especially significant benefit for North Cross students and faculty, North Cross honors these donors with special recognition.

Members of the Head of School's Society hear directly from the Head of School, attend member receptions with the head of school, and take satisfaction in being among a small group of donors who make a tremendous difference at North Cross today.

Membership in The Head of School's Society is available to any donor who gives \$1,200 or more per year to the Annual Fund. For graduates of the last ten years, membership in The Head of School's Society is available at special reduced levels.

## Giving Levels

### HONORING LEADERSHIP DONORS TO THE ANNUAL FUND

**The Founders Society** (Wellington, Northcross, and Slack): \$25,000 minimum gift

**The Honor Circle** (Willis, Eaton, and Ellis): \$10,000 - \$24,999

**The Raiders' Council:** \$5,000 - \$9,999

**The Star:** \$2,500 - \$4,999

**The Cornerstone Society:** \$1,200 - \$2,499 (The giving threshold of the Cornerstone Society will be raised by \$433 each of the next three fiscal years—\$1,633 in 2023-2024, \$2,066 in 2024-2025, and \$2,500 in 2025-2026)

Membership in the Head of School's Society is available to graduates of the last 10 years at the following levels:

- Less than five years since graduation—\$100
- Five to nine years since graduation—\$500
- Ten years since graduation—\$1,000

## THE 1944 CIRCLE

### HONORING NORTH CROSS SCHOOL'S MOST LOYAL DONORS

The 1944 Circle is a special philanthropic society recognizing and honoring the loyal alumni, parents, and friends who support the school consistently over time. This society is not about how much you give; it's about the simple act of giving, year after year.

Membership requirements:

- Your membership in the 1944 Circle begins after your third year of consecutive giving to North Cross.
- The school will count your gifts to any area of the school when determining your years of consecutive giving.
- Recognition is based on gifts, pledge payments, and matching gifts received in a single fiscal year. North Cross School's fiscal year runs from July 1 through June 30.
