Tuition and Fees

North Cross School tuition and fees are shown in the tables below by grade and program. Generally, when all students participate in our programs, most program-related fees are included in tuition. For example, if the grade goes on a field trip, the fee for that trip is included. Tuition includes classroom equipment, intramurals, Symposium (grades 8–12), and standardized assessments in lower grades. Student-specific fees (such as cafeteria charges, books for specific courses, AP tests, lab or art supplies, etc.) are charged to the individual student. North Cross does not charge athletic fees, but parents may be charged if teams incur hotel charges for overnight travel.

Financial aid is available through our Tailored Tuition program for students in grades K–12. A family's Tailored Tuition is based on a family's ability to pay tuition and is intended to help with some of the cost associated with choosing to attend North Cross.

Single, two-, ten-payment options are available for families. There is an additional \$175 convenience fee added for those families who choose the ten-month pay option.

Lemon Dining Hall

Lunch for JK-3 through Grade 4 is \$4.50 per meal. Lunch for grade 4 through 12 is \$5.75. Each meal includes a serving of the main hot entrée and all-you-can-eat vegetables and sides. A full, fresh salad bar and deli tray for sandwiches are also available to students. Price does not include bottled drinks or snacks. Parents are billed monthly for cafeteria charges.
