Supplies ALL students need on the first day of school:

 - Some students prefer to have three 2-inch binders and use them for two classes per binder, while other students prefer to have six 1-inch binders and use one binder per class; discuss with your student what organizational style will work best
- Dividers for binders

- single-subject notebook, spiral bound or composition book
- Texas Instruments 84 or 84 PLUS calculator (no alternatives)
- Pencil pouch
 - Students who struggle with organization may wish to have several pencil pouches that can clip into their binders
- No. 2 pencils, several packs
- Black or blue pens
- 2 red pens
- Highlighters
- 3 packs of index cards, lined or unlined
- Paper planner (for writing down assignments)
- 1 small pack of Post-it notes, any color/size
- Earbuds or headphones (should be compatible with student's Chromebook, but do not need to be expensive)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 packages of Clorox wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

Students in Geometry:

- Compass
- Ruler with centimeters
- 4-inch protractor

A "Geometry Kit" can be purchased at many retailers that contains these necessary tools; they do not have to be purchased individually.

Students in Art:

• Bound sketchbook, at least 100 pages

Students in Band: (optional)
