FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

Dear North Cross Community,

Many of you see me crossing the street each morning with Raider, on my way to school. It is one of the great joys of working in independent school education to be so closely linked to your school and my morning "commute" is a time that I think about all things North Cross. It should not be hard to imagine my thoughts each day as I walked up the hill to the edifice that was Old Slack Hall.

Never one to keep my thoughts to myself, I frequently talked about a new campus to all that would listen. I always felt that Roanoke deserved a top independent school at a level consistent with schools in Richmond, Norfolk, and Charlottesville. More importantly, I saw the effort and dedication of our faculty and staff as they overcame our space limitations in pursuit of excellence. Like Roanoke, they deserved a campus that reflected their dedication to their craft.

But our finances delayed these dreams and it wasn't until four years ago that George Vogel and I sat down with Craig Balzer and his design team to rethink what the campus might look like. From the rudimentary block diagrams that came out of those discussions, John Harlow, our capital campaign consultant and current North Cross parent, met with a number of prospective donors to see whether our dreams were possible. I will never forget my meeting with John when he told me that he could see "absolutely no reason" why we shouldn't begin a campaign with the intent of completing the entire central campus project. I was gobsmacked at his finding that there was so much interest in our project to reinvent the the North Cross campus.

The decision to begin a capital campaign was accompanied by the decision to call the campaign "The Legacy Campaign." We were cognizant that Tom Slack, two generations before us, built the Colonial Avenue campus and a generation ago, the Campaign for North Cross created a modernized Ellis and Slack Halls. Like those before us, our new campaign looked to a bright future, creating a legacy for future generations of North Cross students.

The results are here for everyone to see. With the generosity of our lead donors, continued interest from the Beirne Carter Foundation, and the leadership of our Campaign Chairs, Russ Ellett and Eddie Smith, we successfully raised \$13.2 million and completed construction on time and under budget. The Legacy Campaign is now a success story, firmly a part of the North Cross story.




I would like to thank the entire North Cross community for their support of The Legacy Campaign. You have made a difference for our children and for Roanoke.


MATCHING GIFT CHALLENGE RESULTS




\$550K Challenge Dollars in Response




